

Call for a meeting about the last repressive operations of the

On the 24th June, after a wild demonstration in Basel, 14 comrades* got arrested. In the following days the police conducted several raids in some of the people's offical places of residence. 7 of them are still in pretrial detention.

On the 10th July there were 4 other house searched in Zurich and St. Gallen. The search warrants presented during these raids stated arson of a telecommunication station as the reason for the investigation. The police is not only collecting material but also looking for a comrade. They didn't find the person until now.

These are only the latest events and there are also other cases of repression, that are important to speak about. The purpose of this meeting is not to find "technical" solutions, but to try to analyze the situation together. In the last couple of years with several crisis and the "terrorism threat", the European states have been trying to neutralize its enemies inside and outside of its' boundaries.

In this process the state is starting to target more and more anarchist(and radical) groups and individuals. However, we think that it's important to maintain our determination to destroy this society and continue our projects and fights, even if the state is trying to stop them. We propose a meeting between anarchist and anti-authoritarian comrades to speak about what is going on.

The meeting is not about licking our wounds and taking a step back, but an opportunity to gather, share information and strenghten ourselves in order to fight back.

Our comrades* in prison and on the run are not alone. We are with them – side by side – claiming and defending the practices they are accused of.
